- Acknowledgement of Country
- Aims of the session (E.g. get to know each other, learn, generate shared goals)
- Terminology check
- Introductions – young people, researchers and any other key stakeholders involved (including roles and responsibilities)
- Ice-breakers and warmers to help the group bond and get to know each other
- Introduction to your organisation
- Background to the research project
- Identifying young people’s personal skills and goals relevant to the project
- Ethics 101
- Explanation/introduction to the proposed research methodology
- Roles of young people, level of involvement in the research, time commitments
- Timeline for the project
- Support provided and how your contributions will be recognised
- How we are going to keep each other safe, including child safeguarding if there are any young people under 18 involved
- Who/how to raise a concern/ask for more support
